Exupery International School Student Council Regulations

1. Student Council in EIS is designed as afterschool club, open for students starting from 12 years old. It takes place once a week. Student Council is not elected, students who are willing to take part are welcome on scheduled hours.
2. Once the students is enrolled at the beginning of the semester he or she has to visit the Student Council meetings at least till the end of the semester.
3. The goals of Student Council:
 - 3.1. to enhance student's participation in school governance;
 - 3.2. to give students feeling of control over day-to-day life in school and give them a chance to participate in the school governance;
 - 3.3. to give students teachers' and administrators' prospective on different issues
4. Activities of Student Council:
 - 4.1. to discuss different aspects of school life, evens and issues and to deliver point of view to the whole school (as Student council is not elected it cannot make any decisions for the whole student body);
 - 4.2. to work out and conduct all-school activities or activities held in small groups (charity events, sports events, trips, etc);
 - 4.3. to launch projects to facilitate problem solving (bullying, running in the halls, etc);
 - 4.4. to come up with new school rules, with changes and cancellation of active rules. To do so Student Council has to bring the rule to "We Rule" school assembly (see below);
 - 4.5. appointing a chairman and a secretary for "We rule" school assemblies (see below).
5. "We Rule" school assembly is a community building tool for the whole school.
6. During "We rule" school assemblies students, teachers, and administration members propose, discuss and vote for new rules, procedure, and practices. Any member of the community can come up with the initiative, during the assembly initiative is discussed and voted (every member has one voice, voices are equal). "We rule" assemblies are held once a month.
