

Exupery International School regulations on safety during sports events and activities

Issued in accordance with paragraph 7.7 of Cabinet Regulation No. 1338 "Procedure of safety provision for the students of educational establishments and activities organised there" of 24 November 2009

I General Provisions

- 1 These regulations specify the procedure of safety provisions during sports events and activities at Exupery International School (hereinafter – the School).
- 2 The sports teacher is the responsible person during sports lessons.
- 3 The teacher who conducts event is responsible for the students' physical activities performed during the event.
- 4 The person responsible for sports events is assigned by the Principal/Director.
- 5 The sports teacher is also responsible for the students' safety in the schoolyard (when the lesson/activity takes place there) and in the dressing-rooms. It is prohibited for the students to remain outside after the sports lesson/activity, especially if they have sweated a lot.
- 6 The sports teacher is responsible for the unlocking of the School door (B1D14) prior to the sports activities, and for their locking afterwards, he/she shall get the key from the School guard.
- 7 The person responsible for the sports events coordinates the event regulations with the school governing body, specifying the time, place, approximate number of participants, technical support of the activity and the safety precautions that will be taken.
- 8 The sports events and activities shall take place in the sports facilities equipped to meet the regulatory requirements.
- 9 The sports events and activities shall only take place in the weather conditions which do not endanger the health and safety of the students.
- 10 A medical practitioner or a person assigned by the Principal/Director for the provision of first aid shall be present at the sports events.
- 11 Prior to participation in the sports events for the students from several schools, the responsible person submits to the School Principal/Director a written application, specifying the time, place, list of participants with their personal identification data, class number, year of birth and the date when each student was instructed on the safety precautions, and the date of the latest health check.
- 12 When organizing sports activities, students are enlisted in the interest groups after submission of a health certificate issued by a general practitioner and their parents' signed application.
- 13 During sports events, the presence of 1 adult per 20 students shall be ensured.
- 14 The School nurse or the responsible person shall inform the sports teacher about the health condition of any student after every case of illness or injury, or in cases where special requirements shall be applied for a particular student.
